As in prior considerations, the prevalence of AI tools, specifically with respect to MetriLED's 6-week lifetime projection algorithm and the likelihood of reverse-engineering the UVP algorithm remains deleterious to the organisation. While dissolution is still a consideration, there may exist a pathway to a valid offering outside of the 6WLP; even if unlikely is worth final consideration. As such, the company remains as of Spring 2026.
