1. Statement of Accounting Policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

1.1 Basis of preparation

The unaudited accounts have been prepared in accordance with accounting standards generally accepted in Ireland and the Companies Act 2014. 1.2 Turnover policy

Turnover represents the total invoice value, excluding value added tax, of sales made during the year.
