### Notes to the abridged financial statements for the financial period ended 31st May 2025

#### 1. General information

The company is a private company limited by shares, registered in Ireland. The address of the registered office is CKM Supermarket Limited, 11 ArdCross Court, Crosshaven, Co. Cork.

#### 2. Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with the historical cost convention.
