STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(A) Basis of Preparation

The accounts are prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in Ireland and Irish Statute Comprising of the Companies Act 2014. They comply with the financial reporting standards of the Financial Reporting Council, as promulgated by the Institute of Certified Public Accountants in Ireland. The currency used is the Euro, denoted by the symbol €. The following accounting policies have being applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

(B) TURNOVER

Turnover represents the value of goods and services, exclusive of value added tax.

(C) FIXED ASSETS

The cost of fixed assets is their purchase cost, together with any incidental expenses of acquisition. Depreciation is provided on the bases set out below which are estimated to reduce the assets to realisable values by the end of their expected useful lives.
