

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2025.

1.) ACCOUNTING POLICIES

THE SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES ADOPTED BY THE COMPANY AND APPLIED CONSISTENTLY ARE AS FOLLOWS:

BASIS OF PREPARATION

THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS ARE PREPARED ON THE GOING CONCERN BASIS, UNDER THE HISTORICAL COST CONVENTION AND COMPLY WITH THE FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS OF THE FINANCIAL REPORTING COUNCIL, AS PROMULGATED BY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS IRELAND INCLUDING FRS 102, "THE FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARD APPLICABLE IN THE UK AND REPUBLIC OF IRELAND ("FRS 102") AS ADAPTED BY SECTION 1A OF FRS 102, AND THE COMPANIES ACT 2014 THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS ARE PREPARED IN EURO WHICH IS THE FUNCTIONAL CURRENCY OF THE COMPANY.

CURRENCY

FUNCTIONAL & PRESENTATION CURRENCY, ITEMS INCLUDED IN THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS OF THE COMPANY ARE MEASURED USING THE CURRENCY OF THE PRIMARY ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT IN WHICH THE COMPANY OPERATES ("THE FUNCTIONAL CURRENCY"). THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS ARE PRESENTED IN EURO, WHICH IS THE COMPANY'S FUNCTIONAL & PRESENTATION CURRENCY, AND DENOTED BY THE SYMBOL "€".

TURNOVER

TURNOVER IS RECOGNISED TO THE EXTENT THAT THE COMPANY OBTAINS THE RIGHT TO CONSIDERATION IN EXCHANGE FOR ITS PERFORMANCE. TURNOVER COMPRISES THE FAIR VALUE OF CONSIDERATION RECEIVED AND RECEIVABLE EXCLUSIVE OF VALUE ADDED TAX AND AFTER DISCOUNTS AND REBATES.

TURNOVER FROM THE PROVISION OF SERVICES IS RECOGNISED IN THE ACCOUNTING PERIOD IN WHICH THE SERVICES ARE RENDERED AND THE OUTCOME OF THE CONTRACT CAN BE ESTIMATED RELIABLY.

TURNOVER FROM THE SALE OF GOODS IS RECOGNISED WHEN THE SIGNIFICANT RISKS AND REWARDS OF OWNERSHIP OF THE GOODS HAVE PASSED TO THE BUYER, USUALLY ON DISPATCH OF THE GOODS, THE AMOUNT OF TURNOVER CAN BE MEASURED RELIABLY. IT IS PROBABLE THAT THE ECONOMIC BENEFITS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TRANSACTION WILL FLOW TO THE ENTITY AND THE COSTS INCURRED OR TO BE INCURRED IN RESPECT OF THE TRANSACTION CAN BE MEASURED RELIABLY.

TAXATION

TAX IS RECOGNISED IN THE PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT, EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT THAT IT RELATES TO ITEMS RECOGNISED IN OTHER COMPREHENSIVE INCOME OR DIRECTLY IN EQUITY. IN THIS CASE TAX IS ALSO RECOGNISED IN OTHER COMPREHENSIVE INCOME OR DIRECTLY IN EQUITY RESPECTIVELY.

CURRENT TAX IS CALCULATED ON THE PROFITS OF THE PERIOD. CURRENT TAX IS DETERMINED USING TAX RATES (AND LAWS) THAT HAVE BEEN ENACTED OR SUBSTANTIVELY ENACTED BY THE BALANCE SHEET DATE.

TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS

COST, TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS ARE RECORDED AT HISTORICAL COST OR DEEMED COST, LESS ACCUMULATED DEPRECIATION AND IMPAIRMENT LOSSES. COST INCLUDES PRIME COST, OVERHEADS AND INTEREST INCURRED IN FINANCING THE CONSTRUCTION OF TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS. CAPITALISATION OF INTEREST CEASES WHEN THE ASSET IS BROUGHT INTO USE.

FIXTURES AND FITTINGS, COMPUTER EQUIPMENT & MOTOR VEHICLES ARE STATED AT COST LESS ACCUMULATED DEPRECIATION AND ACCUMULATED IMPAIRMENT LOSSES.

DEPRECIATION IS PROVIDED ON TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS, ON STRAIGHT LINE BASIS SO AS TO WRITE OFF THEIR COST LESS RESIDUAL AMOUNTS OVER THEIR ESTIMATED USEFUL ECONOMIC LIVES.

THE ESTIMATED USEFUL ECONOMIC LIVES ASSIGNED TO TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

OFFICE EQUIPMENT, FIXTURES AND FITTINGS	12.5% STRAIGHT LINE ON COST
EQUIPMENT	12.5% STRAIGHT LINE ON COST
MOTOR VEHICLES	12.5% STRAIGHT LINE ON COST

THE COMPANY'S POLICY IS TO REVIEW THE REMAINING USEFUL ECONOMIC LIVES AND RESIDUAL VALUES OF TANGIBLE ASSETS ON AN ON-GOING BASIS AND TO ADJUST THE DEPRECIATION CHARGE TO REFLECT THE REMAINING ESTIMATED USEFUL ECONOMIC LIFE AND RESIDUAL VALUE.

FULLY DEPRECIATED PROPERTY, PLANT & EQUIPMENT ARE RETAINED IN THE COST OF PROPERTY, PLANT & EQUIPMENT & RELATED ACCUMULATED DEPRECIATION UNTIL THEY ARE REMOVED FROM SERVICE. IN THE CASE OF DISPOSALS, ASSETS AND RELATED DEPRECIATION ARE REMOVED FROM THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND THE NET AMOUNT, LESS PROCEEDS FROM DISPOSAL, IS CHARGED OR CREDITED TO THE PROFIT & LOSS ACCOUNT.

IMPAIRMENT

ASSETS NOT CARRIED AT FAIR VALUE ARE ALSO REVIEWED FOR IMPAIRMENT WHENEVER EVENTS OR CHANGES IN CIRCUMSTANCES INDICATE THAT THE CARRYING AMOUNT MAY NOT BE RECOVERABLE. AN IMPAIRMENT LOSS IS RECOGNISED FOR THE AMOUNT BY WHICH THE ASSET'S CARRYING AMOUNT EXCEEDS ITS RECOVERABLE AMOUNT.

THE RECOVERABLE AMOUNT IS THE HIGHER OF AN ASSET'S FAIR VALUE LESS COSTS TO SELL AND VALUE IN USE. VALUE IN USE IS DEFINED AS THE PRESENT VALUE OF THE FUTURE PRE-TAX AND INTEREST CASH FLOWS OBTAINABLE AS A RESULT OF THE ASSETS CONTINUED USE. THE PRE-TAX AND INTEREST CASH FLOWS ARE DISCOUNTED USING A PRE-TAX DISCOUNT RATE THAT REPRESENTS THE CURRENT MARKET RISK FREE RATE AND THE RISKS INHERENT IN THE ASSET. FOR THE PURPOSES OF ASSESSING IMPAIRMENT, ASSETS ARE GROUPED AT THE LOWEST LEVELS FOR WHICH THEY ARE SEPARATELY IDENTIFIABLE CASH FLOWS (CASH GENERATING UNITS).

IF THE RECOVERABLE AMOUNT OF THE ASSET (OR ASSET'S CASH GENERATING UNIT) IS ESTIMATED TO BE LOWER THAN THE CARRYING AMOUNT, THE CARRYING AMOUNT IS REDUCED TO ITS RECOVERABLE AMOUNT. AN IMPAIRMENT LOSS IS RECOGNISED IN THE PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT, UNLESS THE ASSET HAS BEEN REVALUED WHEN THE AMOUNT IS RECOGNISED IN OTHER COMPREHENSIVE INCOME TO THE EXTENT OF ANY PREVIOUSLY RECOGNISED REVALUATION. THEREAFTER ANY EXCESS IS RECOGNISED IN PROFIT OR LOSS.

IF AN IMPAIRMENT LOSS SUBSEQUENTLY REVERSES, THE CARRYING AMOUNT OF THE ASSET (OR ASSET'S CASH GENERATING UNIT) IS INCREASED TO THE REVISED ESTIMATE OF ITS RECOVERABLE AMOUNT, BUT ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT THE REVISED CARRYING AMOUNT DOES NOT EXCEED THE CARRYING AMOUNT THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN DETERMINED (NET OF DEPRECIATION) HAD NO IMPAIRMENT LOSS BEEN RECOGNISED IN PRIOR PERIODS. A REVERSAL OF AN IMPAIRMENT LOSS IS RECOGNISED IN THE PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT.

LEASES

(I) FINANCE LEASES

LEASES IN WHICH SUBSTANTIALLY ALL THE RISKS AND REWARDS OF OWNERSHIP ARE TRANSFERRED BY THE LESSOR ARE CLASSIFIED AS FINANCE LEASES.

TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS ACQUIRED UNDER FINANCE LEASES ARE CAPITALISED AT THE LEASE'S COMMENCEMENT AT THE LOWER OF THE FAIR VALUE OF THE LEASED PROPERTY AND THE PRESENT VALUE OF THE MINIMUM LEASE PAYMENTS AND ARE DEPRECIATED OVER THE SHORTER OF THE LEASE TERM AND THEIR USEFUL LIVES. THE CAPITAL ELEMENT OF THE LEASE OBLIGATION IS RECORDED AS A LIABILITY AND THE INTEREST ELEMENT OF THE FINANCE LEASE RENTALS IS CHARGED TO THE PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT ON AN ANNUITY BASIS.

EACH LEASE PAYMENT IS APPORTIONED BETWEEN THE LIABILITY AND FINANCE CHARGES USING THE EFFECTIVE INTEREST METHOD.

(II) OPERATING LEASES

LEASES IN WHICH SUBSTANTIALLY ALL THE RISKS AND REWARDS OF OWNERSHIP ARE RETAINED BY THE LESSOR ARE CLASSIFIED AS OPERATING LEASES. PAYMENTS MADE UNDER OPERATING LEASES (NET OF ANY INCENTIVES RECEIVED FROM THE LESSOR) ARE CHARGED TO PROFIT OR LOSS ON A STRAIGHT-LINE BASIS OVER THE PERIOD OF THE LEASE.

(iii) LEASE INCENTIVES

INCENTIVES RECEIVED TO ENTER INTO A FINANCE LEASE REDUCE THE FAIR VALUE OF THE ASSET AND ARE INCLUDED IN THE CALCULATION OF PRESENT VALUE OF FUTURE MINIMUM LEASE PAYMENTS.

INCENTIVES RECEIVED TO ENTER INTO AN OPERATING LEASE ARE CREDITED TO THE PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT, TO REDUCE THE LEASE EXPENSE, ON A STRAIGHT-LINE BASIS OVER THE PERIOD OF THE LEASE.

STOCKS

STOCKS COMPRISE CONSUMMABLE ITEMS AND GOODS HELD FOR RESALE. INVENTORIES ARE STATED AT THE LOWER OF COST AND NET RELIABLE VALUE. COST IS CALCULATED ON A FIRST IN, FIRST OUT BASIS AND INCLUDES INVOICE PRICE, IMPORT DUTIES AND TRANSPORTATION COSTS. NET RELIABLE VALUE COMPRISES THE ACTUAL OR ESTIMATED SELLING PRICE LESS ALL FURTHER COSTS TO COMPLETION OR TO BE INCURRED IN MARKETING, SELLING AND DISTRIBUTION.

AT THE END OF EACH REPORTING PERIOD STOCKS ARE ASSESSED FOR IMPAIRMENT. IF AN ITEM OF STOCK IS IMPAIRED, THE IDENTIFIED INVENTORY IS REDUCED TO ITS SELLING PRICE LESS COSTS TO COMPLETE AND SELL AND AN IMPAIRMENT CHARGE IS RECOGNISED IN THE PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT. WHERE A REVERSAL OF THE IMPAIRMENT IS RECOGNISED THE IMPAIRMENT CHARGE IS REVERSED, UP TO THE ORIGINAL IMPAIRMENT LOSS, AND IS RECOGNISED AS A CREDIT IN THE PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT.

TRADE & OTHER DEBTORS

TRADE & OTHER DEBTORS INCLUDING AMOUNTS OWED TO GROUP COMPANIES ARE RECOGNISED INITIALLY AT TRANSACTION PRICE (INCLUDING TRANSACTION COSTS) UNLESS A FINANCING ARRANGEMENT EXISTS IN WHICH CASE THEY ARE MEASURED AT PRESENT VALUE OF FUTURE RECEIPTS DISCOUNTED AT A MARKET RATE. SUBSEQUENTLY THESE ARE MEASURED AT AMORTISED COST LESS ANY PROVISION FOR IMPAIRMENT.
