### Notes to the abridged financial statements Financial year ended 28 February 2025

#### 1. General information

The company is a private company limited by shares, registered in Ireland. The address of the registered office is O'Neill & Company Chartered Surveyors & Auctioneers Limited, Trident House, Dublin Road, Naas, Co. Kildare.

#### 2. Statement of compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with FRS 105, 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable to the Micro-entities Regime'.

#### 3. Accounting policies and measurement bases

##### Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with the historical cost convention. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is the Companies Act 2014 (the act) and FRS 105 The Financial Reporting Standard applicable to the Micro entities Regime issued by the Financial Reporting Council and promulgated by the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Ireland. The Company qualifies as a micro company for the period, as defined by section 280D of the Act, in respect of the financial year and has applied the rules of the Micro Companies Regime in accordance with section 280E of the Act and FRS 105.

The financial statements are prepared in Euro, which is the functional currency of the entity.

##### Income

Income is generated from service charges and sinking fund contributions received and receivable during the year.

##### Sinking Fund

The sinking fund represents a specific building investment fund reserve to be used only for the purpose of significant expenditure reasonably incurred in the refurbishment, improvement and or maintenance of a non recurring nature. The sinking fund is not guaranteed to cover all unexpected costs of a non recurring nature. Contributions to the sinking fund are billed each financial period in accordance with Section 19 of the Multi Unit Developments Act 2011. Further transfers may be made to the sinking fund from liquid resources in each financial period.
