## Notes to the Financial Statements

### 1. Basis of Preparation:

These Financial Statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the provisions of the Companies Act 2014 relating to micro-companies.

### 2. Accounting Policies:

#### (a) Revenue Recognition:

Revenue is recognized at the point of sale in the online shop when goods are dispatched (or services are rendered) and the significant risks and rewards of ownership have transferred to the customer. Any discounts or returns are recorded as reductions to revenue.

#### (b) Tangible Fixed Assets:

The company holds no tangible fixed assets (e.g., machinery, office equipment). Minor office-related purchases are yet to be bought. If any significant asset were acquired, it would be depreciated on a straight-line basis over its estimated useful life.

#### (c) Intangible Assets:

No internally generated intangible assets (e.g., branding, website development) are capitalized, as they do not meet the criteria for recognition under applicable accounting standards.

#### (d) Share Capital:

The company has 100 ordinary shares held.

#### Profit and Loss (Retained Earnings):

The net profit or loss for the year is determined by subtracting all operating expenses (e.g., marketing, transaction fees, other operating costs) from the revenue. The resulting profit or loss is reflected in "Profit and Loss Account (Retained Earnings)" within Equity.

Bank transactions private capital injections, shareholder distributions) are not recognized as income or expenses but rather as movements in equity or shareholder loans.
